PALM SUNDAY

We start our Holy Week by blessing palms and listening again as Jesus makes his triumphant entry into Jerusalem. It is a story we have heard so many times. It is a story full of imagery and noise!



But have you ever thought what a different story we would be telling today if the unnamed owner of the donkey had refused to give it up? What if that unnamed owner had simply said NO to the request? It would be a completely different entry into Jerusalem for Jesus.

What we fail to appreciate today is that back then a donkey was a very important animal. The donkey was the equivalent of a car, a truck and a tractor all in one.

It was a car because people used it to move around and do their shopping, a truck because it was used to carry load, and a tractor because it was used in cultivating the land. Add to this the fact that the donkey (as we are told in the gospel) had never been ridden, means it was brand new and had a very high market value.

So you can see that giving up the donkey was a very big sacrifice. In fact, it was a generous and heroic act of faith.

As we gather at the start of our Holy Week perhaps the unnamed owner of the donkey might be something to reflect upon. No matter how unknown a person is, they can still play a crucial role in the unfolding of God's plan. The Lord needs each one of us as he needed the unnamed owner of the donkey to trust and to be generous. Perhaps in ways unknown and unfathomable to us at the moment, we are being asked the same question as the donkey's owner *but will our response be as generous*?

GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION

The annual collection for the support of the Church in the Holy Land takes place on Good Friday. This collection promotes the missionary work of the Church in the Holy Land by providing welfare assistance to local Christians in areas such as health, education, employment and housing. Parishes, schools, orphanages and medical centres throughout the Holy Land also rely on assistance from the Good Friday collection.

The collection is also used to maintain 74 churches and shrines associated with the life of Jesus. Last year, Australian Catholics donated \$1.3 million to this cause, despite tough economic times, natural disasters and increasing cost of living, which put a strain on family budgets and financial resources. Your generosity is greatly appreciated. Please remember the Christians of the Holy Land again on this Good Friday. Please also pray that peace and harmony will become a reality in the birthplace of Jesus, the 'Prince of Peace'.

HOW THE COLLECTION IS EVENTUALLY DIVIDED IN THE

HOLY LAND: In accord with Papal instructions, money obtained from the collection is divided between the Congregation for the Oriental Churches and the Latin Patriarchate (35%) and the Custody of the Holy Land (65%).
