FORGIVENESS: 'MEA CULPA', 'MEA CULPA', MEA MAXIMA CULPA'

Everybody knows about forgiveness but how to forgive is a big question.

So, let's look at biblical history of 'forgiveness' from the Old Testament to the New Testament where Jesus shows us the true meaning of forgiveness. Many Christians seem 'not' to favour the God of the Old Testament. We may understand their attitude because Yahweh did not 'talk' about 'forgiveness' explicitly, but many books and authors like the Book of Numbers, Leviticus, Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel, Daniel, Micah and Zechariah did! However, everybody still remembers the familiar words of Psalm 51: "Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin... Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow." (51:2,7).

Jesus of the New Covenant has opened our eyes to 'forgiveness' in a new vision from his death bed on Calvary: "Father, forgive them because they do not know what they are doing." From that moment millions of his disciples followed this new way of love up until our time. From St. Stephen to the Sudanese saint, Josephine Bakhita, and to our own Saint Mary of the Cross MacKillop, their words live forever: "If I was to meet those slave raiders who abducted me and those who tortured me, I'd kneel down to them and kiss their hands, because, if it had not been for them, I would not have become a Christian or a religious person" (St Bakhita). "Whatever troubles may be before you, accept them bravely, remembering Whom you are trying to follow." (St Mary MacKillop)

The 'action' of forgiveness calls upon 'non-resistance' instead of 'resistance'. We may remember the gentle words of Jesus at the High Priest's court: "If I have said anything wrong, tell everyone here what it was. But if I am right in what I have said, why do you hit me?" (John 18:23)

Truly, when we return evil for evil, then the reign of evil has been extended; when we return good for evil – whatever particular form the 'good' may take in a particular instance in a world where the ideal good is seldom an option – then God's kingdom is advanced. So I could translate the Latin words of the Confiteor in the Mass into this way: "I'm sorry", "for getting others into trouble": "I'm very sorry".

So my dear friends, with humble confession we are going to put 'ashes' on our forehead or 'sitting on ashes', as Fr. Ron Roheiser calls, on Ash Wednesday to begin the season of Lent in the coming weeks.

Until then, be good to one another – *Fr. Joseph-Hien*

Book a front seat!

Br Damien Price is a Christian Brother of the Oceania Province. A native of Proserpine in North Queensland, Br Price has taught for over thirty years in schools throughout Queensland. Over the past twenty years Damien has been involved in working with disadvantaged youth, homeless men and women, refugees and Asylum Seekers. Br Damien has Masters Degrees in Counselling and Pastoral Guidance. Damien's Doctor of Philosophy degree focused on the sense of self that youth grow into as they engage with homeless people over an extended period of time.

Br Damien will lead us in this year's Parish Lenten Mini Mission. Following the same format as last year's mission, on Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday (March 7-9) beginning at 9:30am at Our Lady of the Rosary Church will be the morning & hopefully twilight session and then at 4:30pm in the afternoon at Sacred Heart, Maleny. Everyone is encouraged to make the Parish Mini Mission part of your Lenten journey this year.

Lent is only two and a half weeks away with Ash Wednesday falling this year on the 2nd of March. An excellent complement to your Lenten journey is the Little Black Book which contains daily reflections and meditations. It is published in America and once you see past some of the American themes, it has the potential to be a great companion. The challenge is to find 6 minutes each day during Lent. The daily reflections begin from next Sunday so in preparation for Lent the Little Black Books are available from today. We ask a **gold coin donation** to help cover the costs of the books.



The Episcopal Ordination of Timothy John Norton SVD as Auxiliary Bishop of Brisbane will be celebrated at the Cathedral of St Stephen on this Tuesday, February 22nd, at 10.30am. A Taste of Taizé

Taizé is a tiny village in France. Since 1940, it has been home to an ecumenical community of Brothers who pray very simply through chant. During wartime, Br Roger established this community as a place of welcome for Jews who were fleeing the Nazis. Taizé has always had a special solidarity with human suffering. Taizé is, in itself, a symbol of hope and reconciliation. The Brothers take special interest in the poor and in youth who flock to Taizé to reflect on their lives and join in the sung prayer. Join in this beautiful prayer at OLR on Tuesday 15 March at 7pm OR St. George's Anglican Church, 2 Walkers Drive, Maleny on Sunday 6 March at 6.00pm.

Last Tuesday, 70 women came together from different communities within the Parish to Our Lady of The Rosary to experience a day retreat called "Walking with God."

The day was facilitated by Lisa and Chantale from Evangelisation Brisbane.

These faith filled women shared their personal stories of how they walk daily with our Lord. Their stories were challenging and offered the participants insight into their own faith journeys. Lisa and Chantale spoke of strong women in the Bible including Our Lady. They led the participants in silent prayer time, a group discussion, and personal reflection and included meaningful music to enhance the different sessions. Names and phone numbers were exchanged as new friendships were made among the 70 women. The retreat participants were treated to a sumptuous banquet provided by the Caloundra Women's Prayer and Friendship Group, and which was served by some wonderful men in our parish. The retreat was such an outstanding success that many requests for another retreat were made with a different focus.


