Fr Tyrone Deere's Golden Jubilee of Priesthood

Our Parish community has been blessed by the ministry and witness of many retired priests who have called the Sunshine Coast home during their retirement. On this Tuesday, August 9th, Fr Tyrone Deere will celebrate his Golden anniversary of ordination to the priesthood. Fr Tyrone Deere will be 50 years a priest on 9 August, 2022. He was ordained at St Patrick's Cathedral Toowoomba for the Diocese of Cairns, with 3 other Toowoomba priests, on 9 August, 1972. After ministering in several parishes in the Cairns Diocese in 2009 Fr Tyrone retired and moved to Caloundra.

Fr Tyrone regularly celebrates Mass at Landsborough on Friday mornings and is always willing to help out when needed. He will celebrate his 50-year anniversary in Brisbane during the Convocation of Clergy on 16 August, and later in Toowoomba and Cairns during the Priests retreat in September.

We wish Tyrone a blessed Golden Jubilee and thank him for his ministry both in the last 50 years and now.

The Plenary Council Outcomes

A Plenary Council is the most significant and highest gathering of a local church within a country. The Australian Plenary Council begun in 2018 and concluded in July 2022. The purpose of the Plenary Council has been to discuss the future of the Church in Australia through discernment by prayer and dialogue.

What came out of it?

During the process, representative Catholics from across Australia voted on and passed 18 proposals.

Four particular proposals of significance are:

Care for Creation:

Committing all Catholic churches and organisations to adopt 7 major goals for responding to the climate crisis.

Dignity of Women:

Make changes to policies and practices around the involvement of women, including ensuring women are appropriately represented in decision-making and equally remunerated in employment.

Formation for mission:

Ensure leaders have a strong foundation in their faith so that decision-making in mission and ministry comes from a place of faith in God by creating a culture of personal and communal prayer and engagement in the sacramental life of the Church.

Reconciliation:

For the Catholic Church in Australia to formally apologise to First Nations Peoples and actively work towards reconciliation.

What does it mean for me and where to from here?

The Vatican will consider and sign off the proposed outcomes by early 2023. This sign off will allow us to move into the implementation phase and convene Synods and Summits which plot a road map of actions. This will also ensure accountability to the Archdiocese of Brisbane to enact the change required to deliver on the proposals signed off by the Vatican. In the meantime, our Archdiocese will continue to lead the way in a number of the areas identified and begin determining how to embed Plenary Council proposals into our organisation on all levels from Catholic schools and parishes to religious institutes and Catholic organisations.

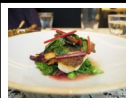
