PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD YEAR A WEEKEND OF 1/2 APRIL 2023

#### **Proper of the Mass**

First Reading: Is 50:4-7 Second Reading: Phil 2:6-11 Gospel: Mt 26:14-27:66

#### TRIUMPHANTLY, LIFE IS GIVEN

Palm Sunday is a feast that is celebrated on a Sunday before Easter. It is a feast that commemorates Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem. Palm Sunday marks the first day of Holy Week. It is the last week of our solemn season of Lent that precedes the arrival of Eastertide. Palm Sunday is celebrated by the blessing and distribution of palm branches representing the palm branches which the crowd scattered in front of Christ as he rode as a King into Jerusalem.

When Jesus entered Jerusalem, the crowd welcomed Jesus waving palm branches and began to sing his praises as they shouted out, *Hosanna*, *Hosanna*, *blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord*. Triumphantly, he marched towards his death which he was not afraid of. He had a mission in his life and that was to save the world through his death. We are born to live but Jesus was born to die for us. Death was for him a goal which he was pursuing, a treasure which he was searching.

Through his death, he gave us life.

What can we learn from Jesus passion and death at this challenging time of ours? Jesus certainly knows our pain and the heavy load that we all bear. The sacrifices we make, however, he saves our life as well as the lives of others. We do not suffer alone, but Jesus too suffers along with us. We are more united in prayer and solidarity for each other. Like Jesus, may we place our complete trust in God's mercy and wisdom, with the confidence that God will give us the grace to get through our struggles.

Those that take Christ for their King, must lay their all under his feet. Hosanna signifies, Save now, we beseech thee! Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord! But of how little value is the applause of the people. The changing multitude join the cry of the day, whether it be Hosanna, or Crucify him. Multitudes often seem to approve the Gospel, but few become consistent disciples. When Jesus came into Jerusalem all the city was moved; some perhaps were moved with joy, who waited for the consolation of Israel; others, of the Pharisees, were moved with envy. So various are the motions in the minds of men upon the approach of Christ's kingdom.

As we celebrate Palm Sunday and begin our journey through Holy Week, we are called to ask ourselves who and where we are in the crowd. This is a week to pray and then decide what kind of followers of Christ we are and are going to be. During this busy week of prayer, liturgies and ceremonies, let us not lose sight of what we are remembering, celebrating and taking part in. As we begin this most holy of weeks, may Jesus be our constant companion. May we enter in the mystery of Jesus' life, death and resurrection with faith and hope.

Get yourself ready to receive the Lord with songs of Hosannas.

#### **Sharing the Chalice**

It is with gratitude and joy to share with you the news that we will soon reintroduce reception of Jesus' Precious Blood from the chalice at Holy Communion. After a consultation with an infectious disease expert, the Archdiocese of Brisbane has received the encouragement to resume normal practices as much as possible due to the fact that "Covid will remain part of the human viral ecology for the foreseeable future."

For our parish, we have decided to begin offering the chalice from the 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter, 6/7th May. In order to prepare for this, **training for community leaders will be offered at the OLR Parish Centre Egan Room at 9.30am on Thursday, 20<sup>th</sup> April.** This training aims to empower at least one person from each of our Masses to go forth and train other extraordinary ministers. Between now and then, if you are interested in becoming an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion please leave your name and contact details with your community leader and/or Mass coordinator.



#### Planning support for the Voice.

Members of the Catholic, Anglican and Uniting Churches met with the Sunshine Coast Reconciliation Group Inc. in the Dobson Room on 17<sup>th</sup> March to exchange plans on how to support the Voice in the coming referendum.

Archbishop Mark Coleridge has already committed to an Indigenous Voice and said "I'm strongly committed to the Voice. I've listened to important and convincing indigenous voices on this topic." More information will be provided by the Archbishop later this year and there will be the opportunity to find out more about the issues.
