Catholic Leadership Intensive

16 parishioners who are part of the six Ministry Leadership Teams recently took park in the ten-week Catholic Leadership in the Parish Centre Egan Room via a live-streaming hub from Holy Spirit Seminary. Every Monday evening for ten weeks, these 16 gathered from Maleny, Caloundra and Unity communities to invest in their capacity to lead in a parish context. On Friday evening this week, the participants celebrated their graduation with a Mass and celebratory dinner at the Seminary in Brisbane. It is important that we celebrate investment in leadership and faith because in doing so, we begin charting a new course in church culture – a culture in which lay people have both the right and capacity to lead in a parish context. CLI Testimony: I recently took the opportunity to participate in the 2023 Catholic Leadership Intensive. This has been a wonderful experience for me, both personally and as a part of the ministry leadership teams of our parish. I have grown immensely in my faith and have learned that the Holy Spirit is beside me always, I need to pray and God will answer me, sometimes in unexpected ways. The greatest lesson and life changing moment I experienced on the course was listening to Bishop Tim Norton talking about his journey and how he came to be in Brisbane. I had recently been asked to take on a role for which I was unsure I was the right person. I prayed for guidance and I truly believe that God sending Bishop Tim to tell his story was God's way of answering my prayers. I walked out of the room that evening knowing I was going to say yes. I told myself that if Bishop Tim can say yes and get on with it, then so can I. So I said yes to you, God.


Thank you for your generosity in giving, service and love. Generosity is one of our parish's primary values.

Kingdom Youth Group Update

Youth group nights have concluded for the term, and so I wanted to update the community on how we have been travelling. This year we have been journeying with the theme "Jesus, Transform Me," looking at how we can be transformed into the people God calls us to be if we invest in a relationship with Him. Our topics have included how this relationship with Jesus can transform us heart, mind, and soul — to love others first, to think and act with Christian values, and to drawer closer to Jesus in prayer. We then looked at our relationships with others — how to forgive, to love others as we want to be loved, and to love even through hardship. Finally, we looked at prayer — to the Saints for examples and how to pray for the vulnerable. We ended the term with Adoration, an encounter that some students experienced for the very first time.
