Gaudete Sunday

In the 3rd week of Advent we light the Rose coloured candle in the advent wreath. Rose is the liturgical colour for this Sunday which is called Gaudete Sunday, meaning *Rejoice!* (For you language enthusiasts, "Gaudete" is a Latin word in it's imperative form, implying immediate action such as Stop! Go! Be Quiet!). Gaudete is almost an assertive encouragement to *Rejoice!* We could also call it "Be Joyful Sunday". The Church, in her wisdom, gives us a break from the reflective and penitential purple and instead we are reminded of the celebratory and joyful mood at the nearness of the coming of Jesus.



So as the readings exhort you today count your blessings, sing a song of gladness and let your soul rejoice - with the Prophet Isaiah, with the Psalmist (possibly written by King David), and rejoice and be happy along with St Paul in the second reading. As we wait in joyful anticipation for the *Adventus* of Christ the

Faith and Formation

The Parish Faith and Formation Ministry provides opportunities for spiritual and prayerful accompaniment, catechesis and formation experiences. Our overarching theme is the 'Journey in Faith'. The Journey in Faith program in our Parish hopes to find, support and guide each of you on your personal journey into a deeper relationship with Jesus. Opportunities for Formation include:

- Alpha
- Faith Formation Hour Weekly Catechesis
- RCIA program for catechumenates and candidates
- Faith Circles small group studies
- Links to online resources

Alpha in 2024. We will start Course #1 for the year in the first week of February with courses running at OLR on Tuesday evenings, at Landsborough on Friday mornings, and at Southern Cross Care, day tbc. Please consider, in this coming Year of Invitation, who you may be able to invite. Further courses will run in May and October.

Faith Formation Hour (FFH) offers ongoing catechesis for all parishioners under the direction of Fr Francis. FFH will be offered weekly on **Thursday from 4-5pm** in 2024 at the Parish Centre at OLR, with Zoom capability for those wishing to join from the comfort of your homes.

- Know Your Faith: Commencing 11/1/2024, the Know Your Faith course will run every week up to Easter. It is based on the *At Home with God's People* text and will offer a great refresher to the basic tenets and beliefs of the Catholic Church.
- Unlocking the Mystery of the Bible will commence after Easter. This is an eight-week journey through salvation history using the Great Adventure Bible timeline from Ascension Press.

Faith Circles are small group opportunities for bible study, prayer groups, book discussions etc. Currently parishioners including John Manion, Carol Devcich, Caroline Kettle and Julie Borger are providing Faith Formation opportunities in this small group model across our Parish. Starting January 18, John is leading a 10-session Bible Study on the Eucharist from 8am-9.30am at the Good Shepherd Centre, Kawana. For all available Faith Circle opportunities, visit the Parish website and click on *Faith and Formation*, under *Ministry Areas*, or go to Linktree to register.

Anyone can run a Faith Circle. The Faith and Formation Ministry is putting together resource packs to support volunteer Faith Circle leaders with the first resource being the Practice of Prayer. What Faith Circle could you offer, or could you join? Can a few friends meet at your place over a coffee and journey in faith together?

The Date of Christmas

Early Church documents show that the birth of Christ has been celebrated in Rome on 25 December since the early fourth century. How and when was it decided that this was the date of Christ's birth?

The most common theory is that Christians took over the date of the pagan feast of the Unconquered Sun which was proclaimed by the Emperor Aurelian in 274 AD. As the days stopped getting shorter and the hours of sunlight began to increase at the time of the winter solstice (December 25 in early calendars), people celebrated the sun's rebirth. Christians, who saw Christ as the true unconquered light of the world, celebrated his birth date on the same day.

Other researchers suggest a different theory. Scripture gives the date of Christ's death as 14 Nisan, the fourteenth day of the spring moon. It was calculated that the equivalent date in the Roman calendar that year was 25 March. Early Christians believed that the lives of patriarchs spanned a whole number of years from conception to death. This resulted in their conviction that Christ was conceived on the same date that he died, 25 March. In fact we celebrate the Annunciation on that date. Adding exactly nine months (because Christ is the perfect human being) gives 25 December as the date of his birth.

This connection between Christmas and Easter reflects a theological link. If it had not been for Christ's passion, death and resurrection, we would not be celebrating Christmas at all! **By Elizabeth Harrington.**
