Happy Mother's Day

The role of mother is one of the most unchanging and reliable sources of love and support in the world and so today we embrace the special opportunity to honor all mothers and maternal figures. In the words of the 14th century philosopher and theologian, Meister Eckhart, who said, "If the only prayer you ever said was, 'thank you,' it would be enough," we say "Thank you" to all mothers and maternal figures in our lives. Where would we be without the nurture of a mother's unconditional love? A mother's love is truly the reflection of God's love for humanity.

Friends, God's love for us – mirrored in a unique way through mothers – is the essence of the Good News. Today's Feast of the Ascension celebrates the enthronement of Jesus at the right hand of God, part of the preparation for us to receive the Holy Spirit. In his final words to the disciples, Jesus said, "I will be with you always, to the end of time" (Mt 28:20). These words are indeed God's promise of love and are reflected in a mother's nurturing and sometimes fierce love for her offspring. Jesus really is present in the love of a mother because "God is love" (1 Jn 4:8).
